I am Looking For:Information concerning James H McCullough in Ohio, and Illinois abt 1836 as I have a letter written by James H McCullough to his father-in-law Mathew Stephenson in Frankfort, IL. He mentions going to newly purchased lands in Coles, now Cumberland County, IL, in the fall or Spring. He purchased some 1,000+ acres there. James H McCullough and Mathew Stephenson's daughter Jane were married in Livingston County, KY in 1826?, moved to Galatan County, IL where James H served in the "Blackhawk War" (did not see action) . James H purchased 40 acres in Franklin County,IL in 1832 and then moved to Franklin County, OH where his father was living also. In this letter he mentions that they just had a new child recently, a girl baby and that his business was a little slow. He mentions that he was caring for a maid and 8 children as well as for himself and Jane.

The following is her obituary which appeared in: The Miami Helmet news paper in Piqua, Ohio USA dated Thursday April 16, 1896. "In Memory of Jane Dankworth" Jane [McCullough] Dankworth was born in Omah, County Tyrone, Ireland, April 25, 1823; died April 12, 1896 and was therefore 72 years, 11 months and 17 days of age. She came to this country when in her 15th year, remaining permanently. She united with the Salem Methodist Church, of Philadelphia, PA [USA], in her early womanhood and had been allied to the Methodist faith up to the time of her decease, although, for a number of years, ill health prevented her attendance at church. She was married to John Dankworth, December 29, 1851, they coming to Ohio [USA], the following year. The husband and three sons mourn her loss. The decea! sed was laid to rest in Forest Hill Cemetery, Tuesday afternoon after services conducted at the residence by Rev. W. H. Wehrly. Thus closed the life of one of Piqua's patient, useful and worthy Christian women, wife, mother and friend who will be greatly missed in the home of which she was the light and stay, and by all to whom she was known. She did with her might what her hands found to do.
