I have been trying to trace the family of my great-grandmother, Fannie McCullough. Her name was Francis Maria McCullough, born 02/18/1861, died 08/07/1940). She married William L. Yauger May 13, 1881, probably in Indiana. My grandfather, John Blane Yauger, was born in Middletown, Indiana. She had a brother Cyrus L. McCullough (1852-1921) who was about 10 years older. They eventually moved to Wichita County, Texas and are buried in the cemetery at Iowa Park. One source indicates there was another brother, James. Fannie and William Yauger had three children, John Blane

Yauger (1884-1909), Cyrus Ramie Yauger (1884-1962), and Elizabeth D. (Lizzie) Yauger Tyson (1888-1921). My great-grandmother was a founding member and active until her death in the Christian Church in Iowa Park, TX, as I notice your family also was. I have not been able to get much detail from Indiana records so far.
