I will be happy to pay for copying and postage, and can offer a copy of a book prepared on one branch of this McCullough family in 1912. It includes an account by James' son John of his eight year captivity among the Delaware Indians in western Pennsylvania (as referenced in another recent posting) and traces one branch of descent in Franklin County down to 1912. I can also supply data on my wife's family which branches off earlier and moves to Ohio, then Illinois and then Oklahoma.
